Woodbury Speed Bumps – Update: Sarah Thompson of Charleston Management sent a letter to the Town of Hillsborough asking for speed tables on Woodbury Drive. As soon as the HOA hears back from the Town, the Board will proceed with the petition.

New Street Light: A street light was installed at the Beckett's Ridge Drive "extension" entrance to the neighborhood as a safety measure and to help deter vandalism.

Tot Lot Fences- Update: The broken tot lot gates and fences were replaced in mid-September.

Retention Pond Landscaping: The contracted landscape architect is working on plans for all retention ponds for the Board to review this fall.

- **Parking:** The streets of Beckett's Ridge were not intended to accommodate regular on-street parking. While everyone will have an occasional need to park on the street, please fill your driveway first and encourage your guests to park in your driveway. Parking a car in the right-of-way area on the side of the road (typically the grassy area in between the road and sidewalk) is a violation of town ordinance and HOA covenants.
- Garbage Cans & Recycling Bins: After the weekly trash & recycling pick up occurs, garbage cans and recycling bins need to be properly stored out of view. Please do your part to help keep our neighborhood looking nice.

Seasonal Recipe – Pumpkin Roll

- Beat together: 3 eggs, 1 cup sugar
- Mix into egg mixture: 2/3 cup pumpkin, 1 tsp lemon juice,
- Sift together and fold into pumpkin mixture: 3/4 cup flour, 1 tsp baking powder, 2 tsp cinnamon, 1 tsp ginger, 1/2 tsp salt
- Spread into greased & floured cookie sheet and bake at 375 degrees for 15 minutes
- Turn out on smooth towel sprinkled with confectionary sugar -- Allow to cool 3 minutes and spread filling on cake and roll up
- Filling: 1cup confectionary sugar, 2 -3 oz packages cream cheese (softened), 4 tbs butter or margarine, 1/2 tsp vanilla -- Beat until smooth.
