Hampton Pointe, Old Mill & Waterstone Development Activity On July 26, the Planning Board and Town Board of Commissioners reviewed a special use permit application from Gandhi, Inc. to locate a gas station/convenience store/car wash/Huddle House restaurant in Hampton Pointe. This meeting was continued and there will be additional discussion about the proposal. Public comment will be accepted at the next meeting. (The Town Board will reschedule the continuation after its September 12 meeting.) This application was also discussed at the August 2nd Planning Board meeting. Municipal Election — November 8, 2005

On November 8, Beckett's Ridge residents have the opportunity to cast votes for Hillsborough's mayor and two Hillsborough town commissioners. Hillsborough has three voting precincts: Hillsborough (Downtown), West Hillsborough(West Hillsborough and Fairview) and Grady Brown (Beckett's Ridge, Granview, Cornwallis Hills & everything south of the Eno River). In the 2003 Municipal Elections, 946 Hillsborough citizens voted (2000 census pop. 5,446). The Hillsborough precinct reported 369 voters, West Hillsborough precinct reported 286 voters, and Grady Brown Precinct report 291 voters. In Beckett's Ridge, only 93 individuals voted for Mayor and Town Board. By voting in the upcoming municipal election, BR residents can get more involved with town governance and help shape the quality of life in Hillsborough.
